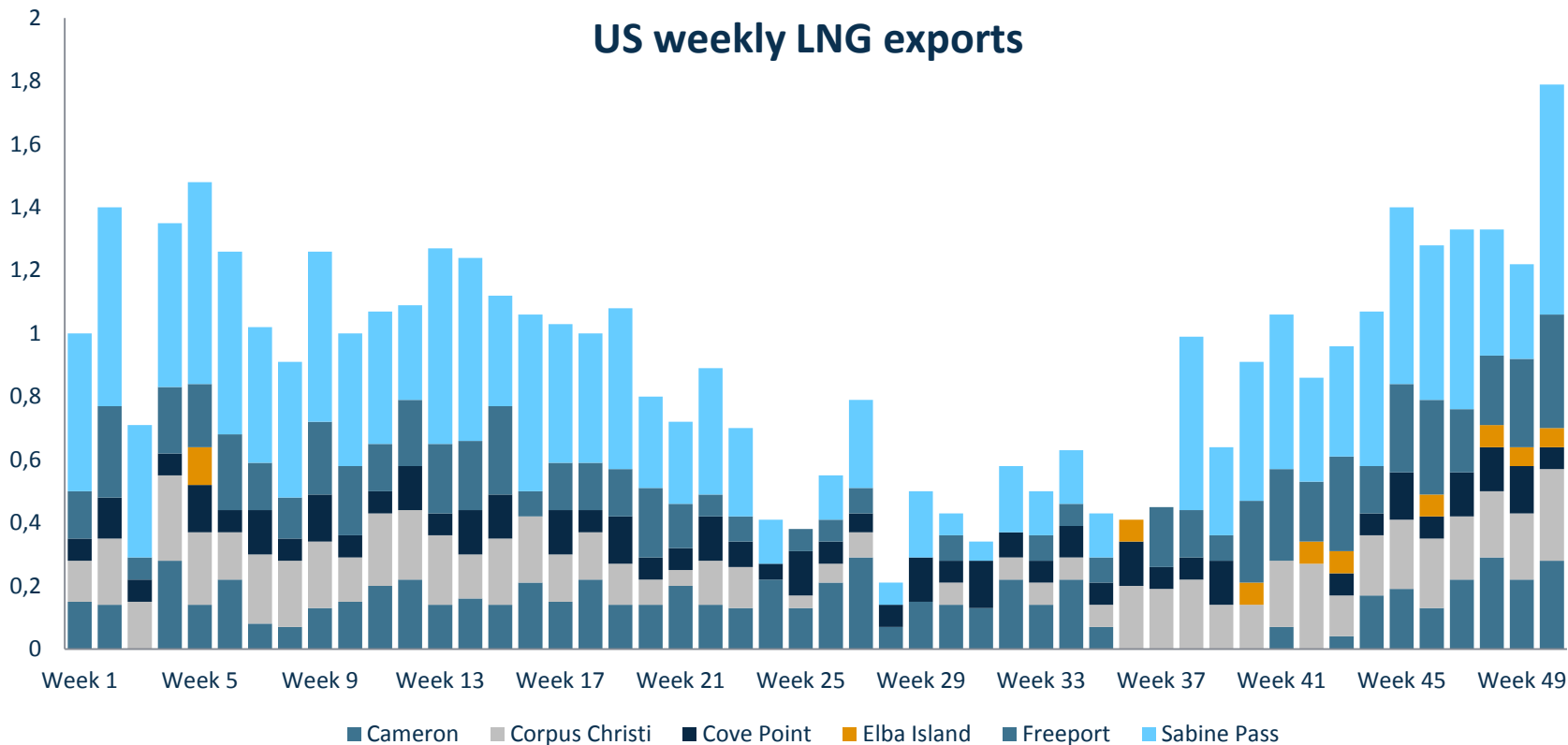

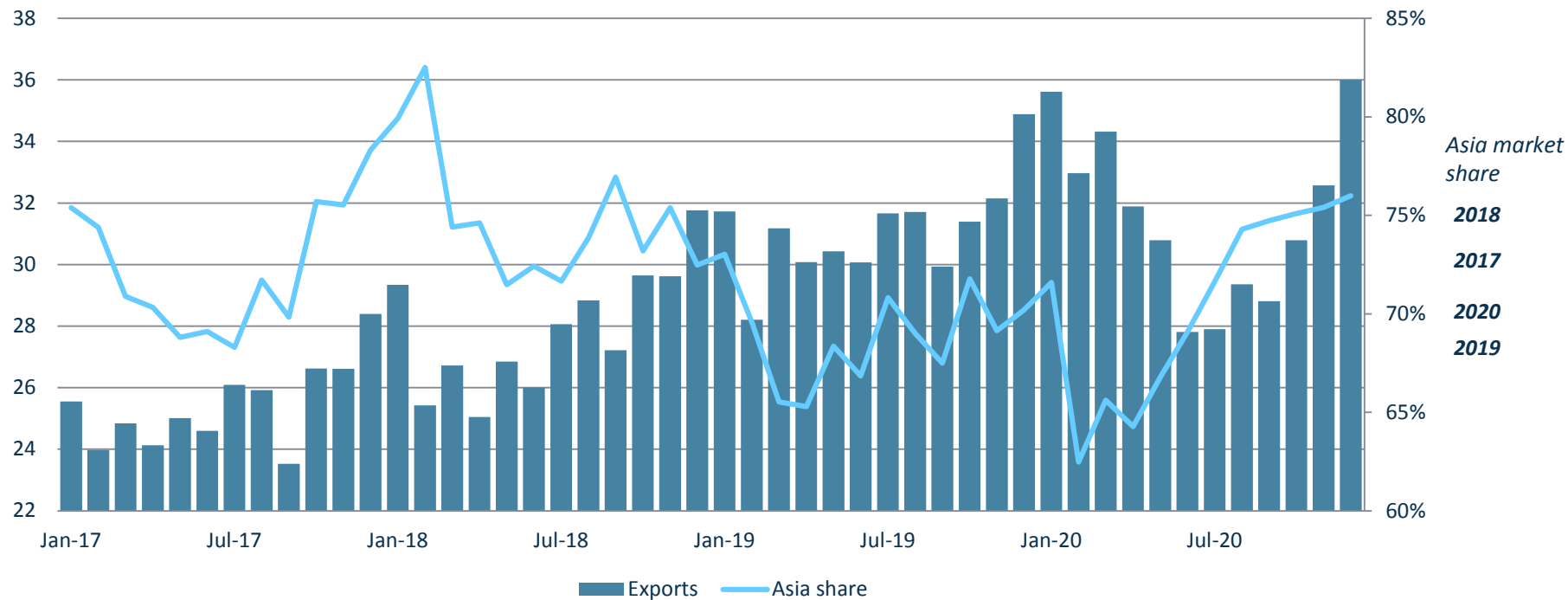
US EXPORTS BACK AT FULL CAPACITY



ASIA PULLING THE CARGOES



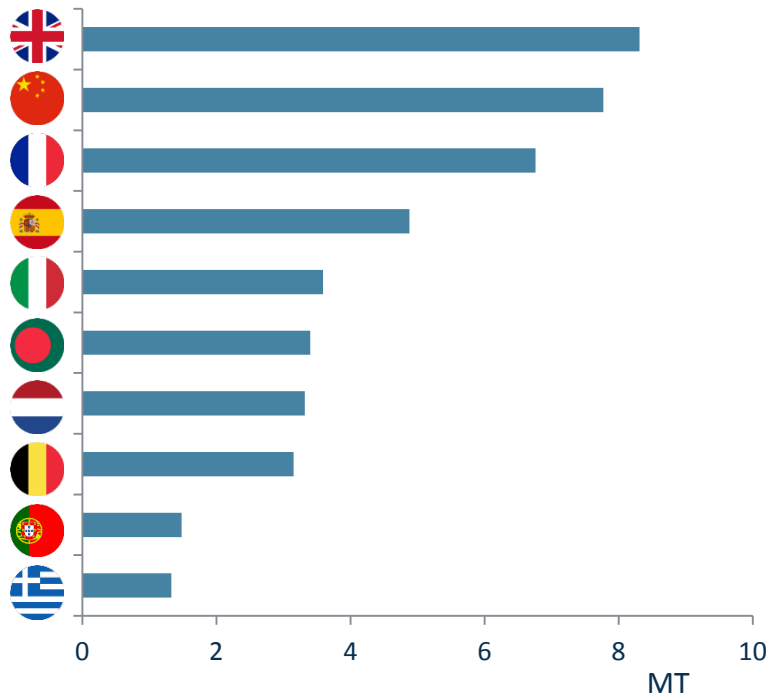
Monthly LNG Exports and Asia market share



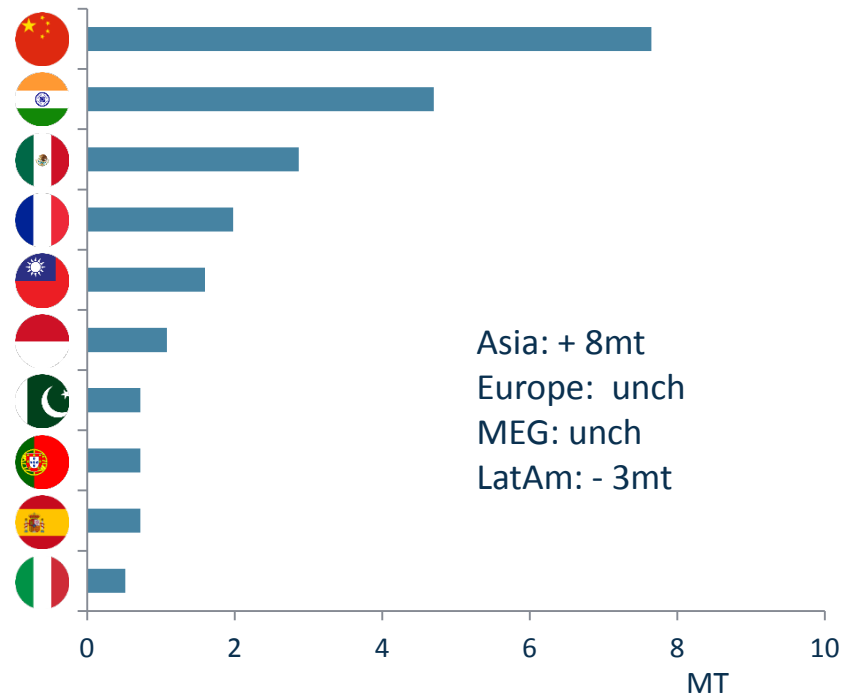
FROM EUROPEAN SINK TO ASIAN PULL

Asia absorbed >150% of 5MT growth in 2020

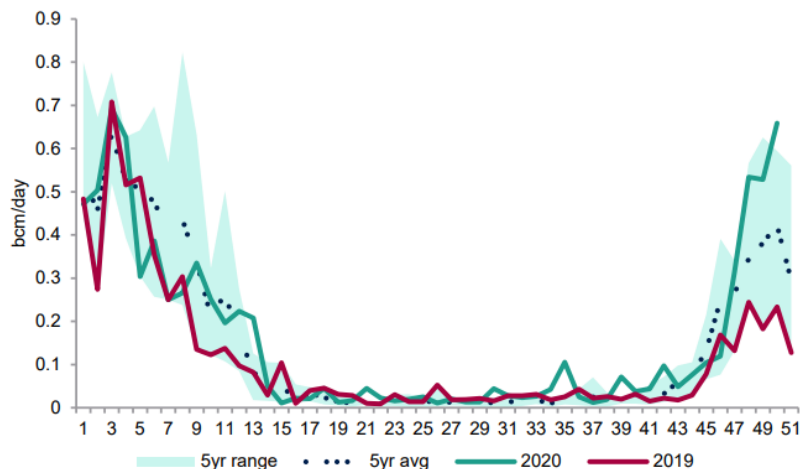

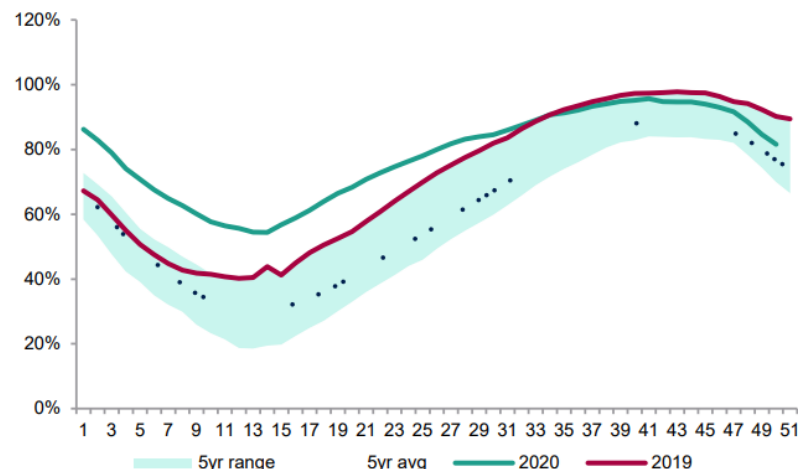
RESULTING IN EUROPEAN STORAGE LEVELS COMING DOWN



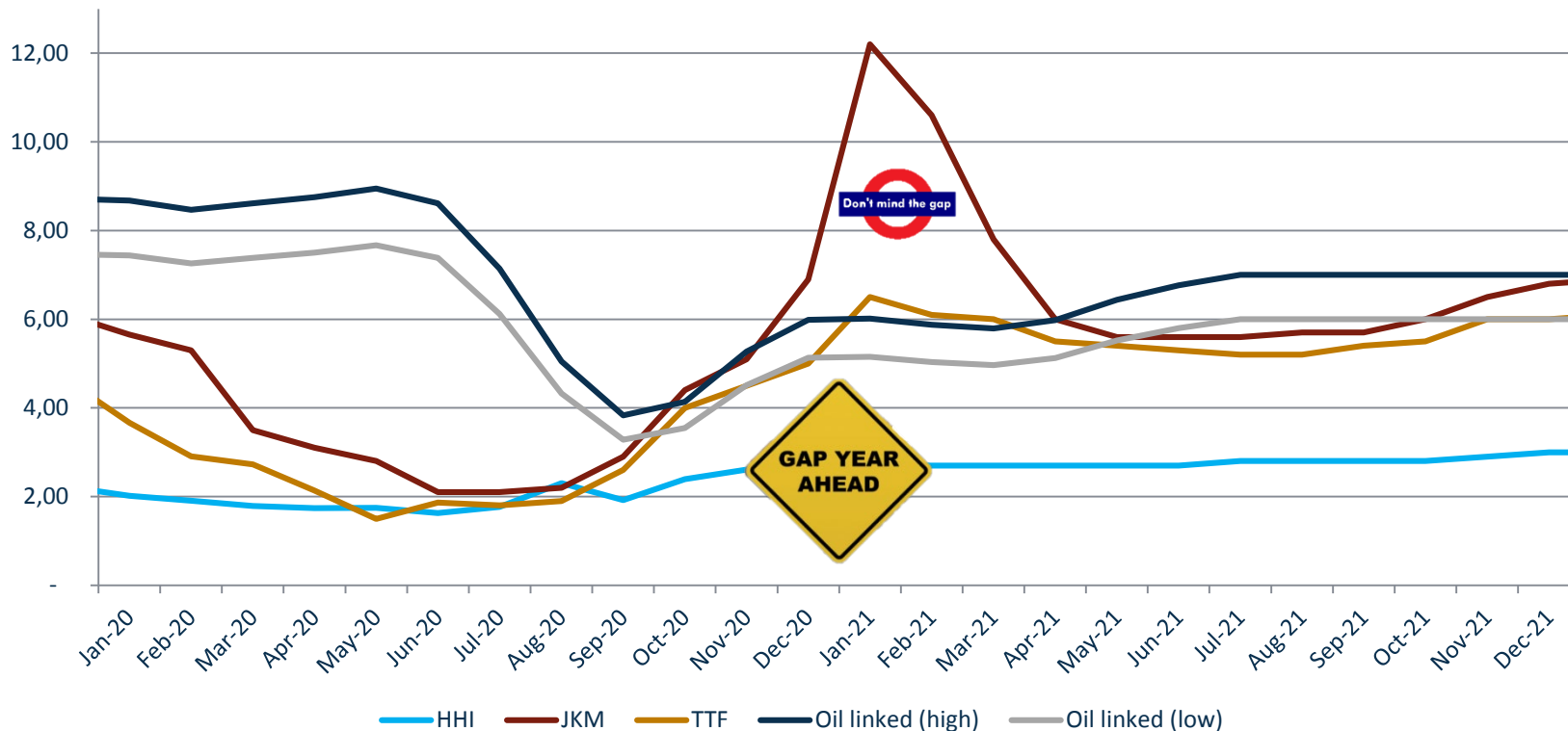
European Gas Withdrawals



European Gas Storage % full



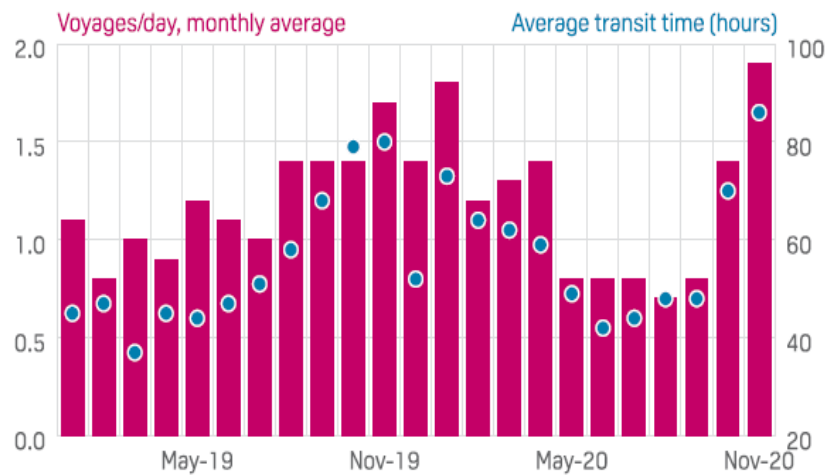
LNG PRODUCT PRICES AND ARBITRAGE SPREADS SOARED



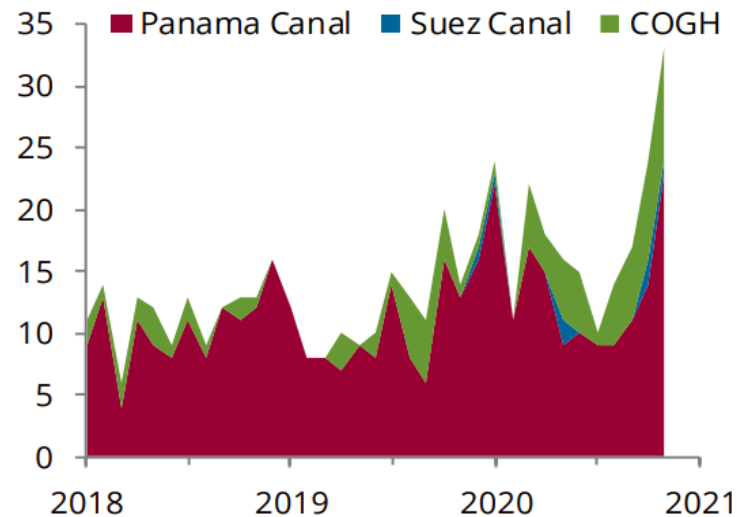
SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS AND CONGESTIONS



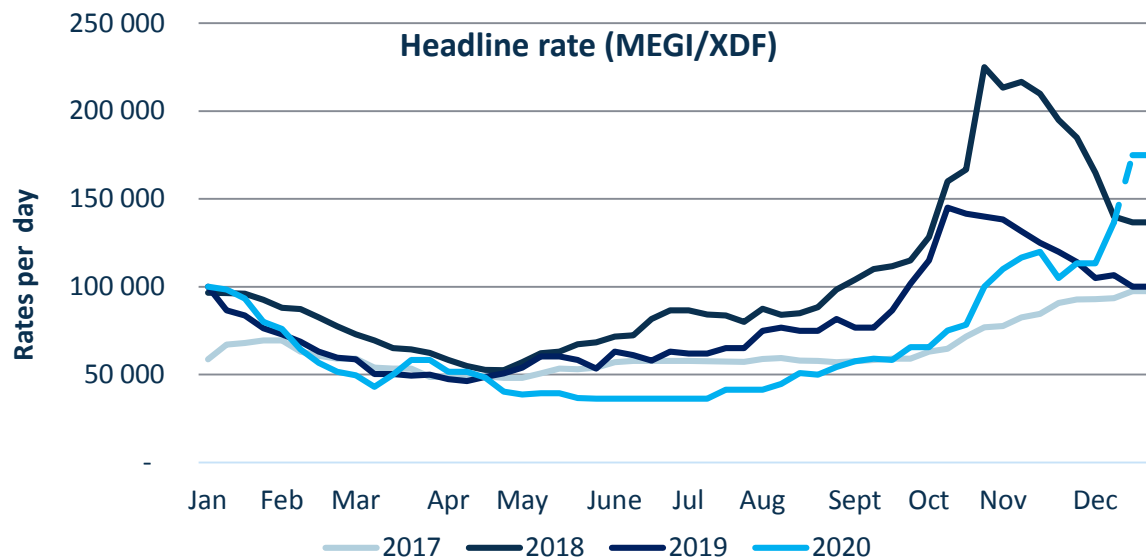
Panama LNG Transits



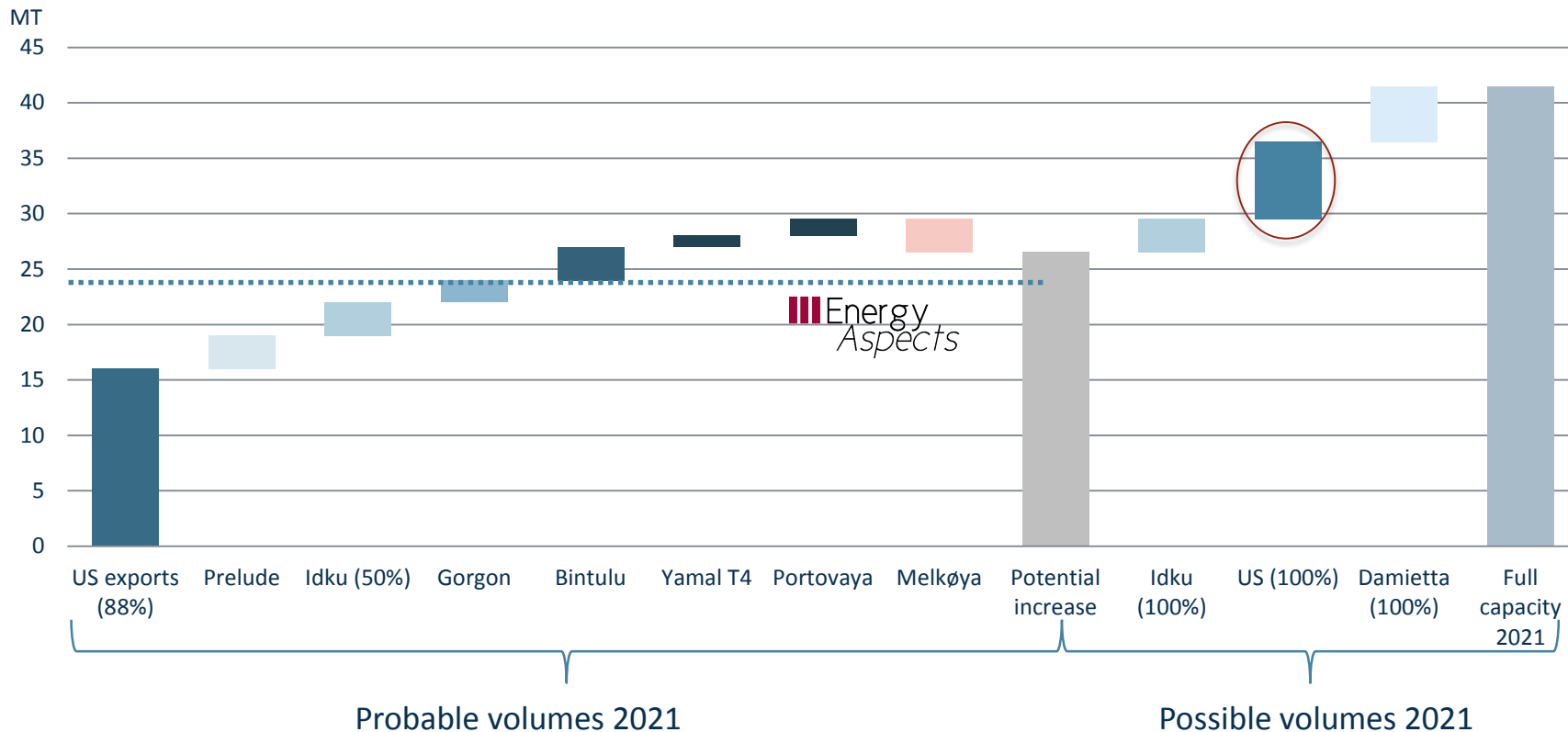
US LNG Cargo routes



RESULTING IN SOLD OUT MARKET FOR SHIPS



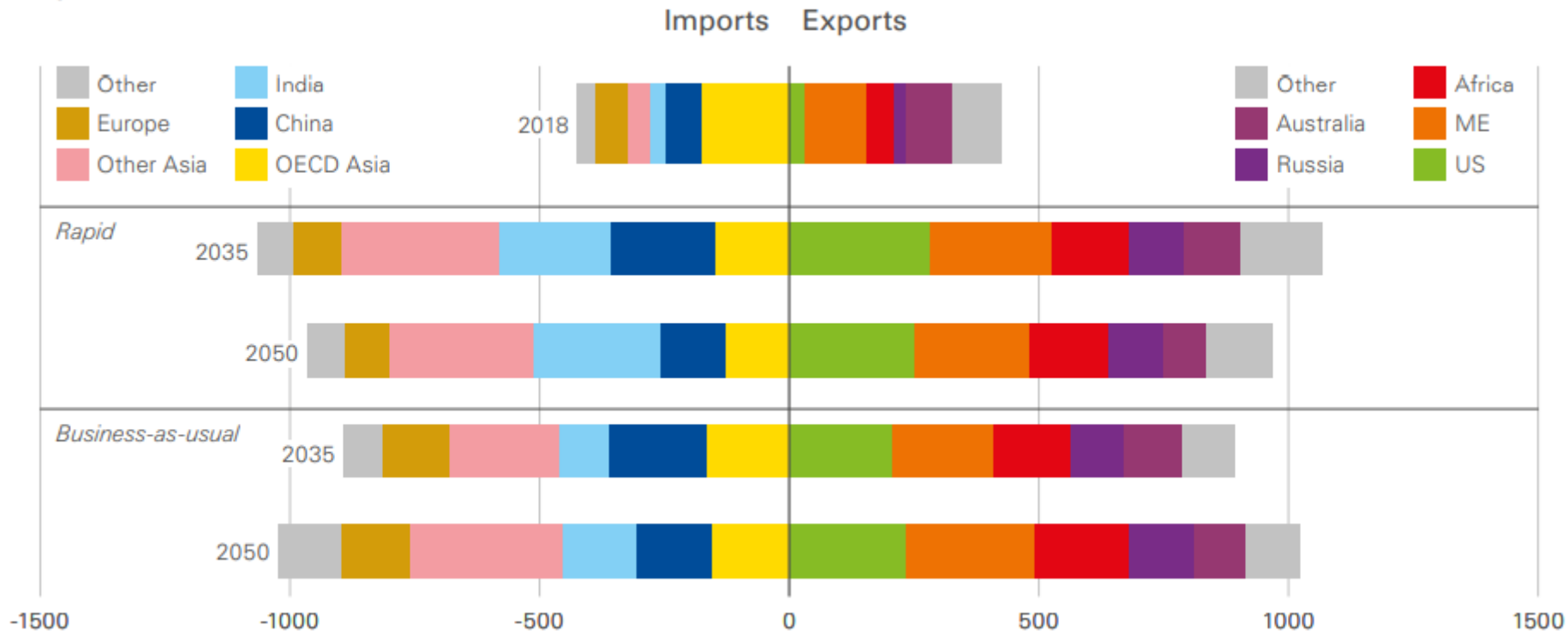
SIGNIFICANT LNG AVAILABLE IN 2021 DESPITE LIMITED NEW VOLUMES
